STORM DAMAGE ON SR-74

Riverside County – A section of State Route 74 (SR-74) near Palm Desert was damaged by flash flooding yesterday, Monday, August 4. The damage took place between Carrizo Road and Vista Point in Riverside County. Sections of pavement were washed away along with large rock slides, mud flow, and drain blockage.

Caltrans maintenance crews worked into the evening yesterday and have continued work to restore the route today. The cleanup work may last through the end of the week.

The road remains open with one lane available to motorists with traffic control during the daytime work. Additional work will be necessary to make permanent repairs to the shoulder and drains. It is expected to take place once funding and equipment are secured, possibly in the next few weeks.
