## LANE CLOSURES ON STATE ROUTE 18 NEXT WEEK

**SAN BERNARDINO** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is cleaning drains, reestablishing flow in roadside culverts and removing weeds next week at three locations on State Route 18 (SR-18) between Stanfield Cut-off and County Dump Road (Lucerne Valley side).

Locations and hours are as follows:

Baldwin Lake Rd. to County Dump Rd., post miles 58.4 to 59.0	Wed., 8/10 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.	Cleaning drains and culverts
Coleman to Gold Mountain Dr., post miles 56 to 57.8	Thursday 8/11 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.	Cleaning drains and culverts; weed removal

One way traffic control will be in effect. Anticipate minor delays. Advisory signs have been posted in advance to alert drivers.
