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REPAIRS BEGIN ON STATE ROUTE 74

RIVERSIDE COUNTY- California Department of Transportation has awarded a \$1.6 million contract to Valley Slurry Seal to repair three surface sections of State Route 74 (SR-74) between the Orange County line and Palm Desert. Repairs begin today and will occur on an 11 mile segment between Orange County Line and Grand Avenue in Lake Elsinore; a six mile segment between Riverside *Street* and I-215 in Perris; and from SR-371 in Anza to the Palm Desert City limits. Crews will work 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday.

Traffic control is based on local highway configuration. One lane, if possible, will remain open in each direction of travel. One way traffic control will be conducted through two lane segments. Plan ahead; add time to your commute.
