BRIDGE DECK REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO BEGIN ON INTERSTATE 10 AT THE STUBBY WASH BRIDGE IN BANNING

This project will replace significant portions of the bridge deck, repair bridge soffits, and seal the entire deck with methacrylate. The project was awarded to Building Consulting Engineers, Inc. of Chino Hills for approximately \$1.48 million dollars. Construction is scheduled to begin on August 21.

Also, the bridge will be widened due to the need for temporary detours during the construction which should help alleviate delays. This added approximately \$500,000 in costs to the project for the bridge widening detours. The work will begin at night for the first three – four weeks until the K-rail has been placed. It will then switch to daytime work for the remainder of the project.

The contractor will be installing construction area signs on Thursday, August 16 and the contractor will begin mobilizing on Tuesday, August 14 so there may be visible dust in the work area. All work is subject to weather conditions.

The work is expected to last through June-2013. Please follow all advisory signs and **SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE.**
