NIGHTTIME LOCAL STREET CLOSURES IN DEVORE AUGUST 11 TO AUGUST 16, 2014

No planned nighttime closures on I-15 or I-215

DEVORE, Calif. – As part of the Devore Interchange Project, crews will conduct nighttime activities. This will necessitate local street closures for the safety of the public and workers. Following are details of construction activities that will begin on Monday night, August 11 and end on Saturday morning, August 16, 2014. Closure restrictions will be lifted each day so motorists can travel at peak daytime traffic times. Noise can be expected with these activities. Please note that information contained in this commuter alert is subject to change without notice based on weather, field conditions or other operational factors.

Devore Road between Cajon Blvd. and NB I-215 Devore Road Off-Ramp – One lane open with flagging	Sun., August 10 – 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.	No detour is necessary as one lane will be open with a flagging crew.
Glen Helen Pkwy. I-15 Underpass	Mon., August 11; Tues., August 12; Wed., August 13; Thurs., August 14; Fri., August 15 – 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.	Travel south on Glen Helen Pkwy. to Sierra Ave. and continue to desired destination.
Glen Helen Rd. I-15 Underpass – One lane open with flagging	Mon., August 11; Tues., August 12; Wed., August 13; Thurs., August 14; Fri., August 15 – Intermittently day and night	No detour is necessary as one lane will be open with a flagging crew.
Kenwood Ave. I-15 Underpass	Mon., August 11; Tues., August 12; Wed., August 13; Thurs., August 14; Fri., August 15 – 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.	The underpass will re-open each day. Cleghorn Rd. to the north of Kenwood Ave. and Devore Rd. to the south can be used to access I-15 in the NB or SB direction.
