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Interstate 10 Pavement Project in Palm Springs Area Update #4

Riverside County – Construction continues next week to do final striping, apply fog seal and replace electronic traffic detector loops on 20 miles of Interstate 10 (I-10) in Riverside County. The project extends from Monterey Avenue in Thousand Palms/ Rancho Mirage to State Route 111 in Palm Springs.

Lanes will be closed as needed during the dates and times shown below. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time.

Eastbound and Westbound I-10 from Monterey Ave in Thousand Palms to SR-111 in Palm Springs. NOTE: Alternating on- and off-ramps in this area may be closed to install traffic sensor loops. 	Monday night, August 17 – Thursday morning, August 20	7:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m.	No more than two lanes will be closed at one time in each direction to install traffic sensor loops.
	Thursday, August 20 and Friday, August 21	8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.	Moving lane closure to apply fog seal to shoulders
	Wednesday night, August 19 – Friday morning, August 21	7:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m.	Moving lane closures for striping and pavement markers

Please follow all advisory signs and **SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE**. The California Highway Patrol will be enforcing reduced speed limits in the construction zone. Work will continue next week to do final striping and add pavement markers.
