DIG OUT PROJECT REPAIRS PAVEMENT ON STATE ROUTES 173, 189, AND 138

SAN BERNARDINO – Caltrans will begin a \$4.6 million highway maintenance (HM) funded project to dig out damaged pavement in various locations and replace it with new pavement and an overlay on State Route's (SR's) 173, 189 and 138 in the San Bernardino Mountains.

Work will begin on Monday, August 27 and start with SR 173 between North Bay Rd and SR 18, then SR 189 from SR 18 to SR 173, and finally on 138 from SR 18 to SR 173.

All American Asphalt is the contractor for the project and the work hours are Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. with flagging. The project is expected to last until fall 2012.

Motorists are advised to plan ahead and take alternate routes to avoid delays. To keep apprised of road information throughout the State by using the Caltrans Quick Map at <http://quickmap.dot.ca.gov/>.
