COLORADO RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT TRAFFIC SWITCHES TO THE NEW BRIDGE NEXT WEEK

Riverside County- Caltrans, the Arizona Department of Transportation and MCM Construction continue the \$29.6 million dollar project on State Route 62 to construct a new bridge across the Colorado River between Big River, California and Parker, Arizona.

One half of the new structure is nearing completion and traffic will be switched to the new structure on Tuesday, August 21 or Wednesday, August 22. Drivers can anticipate minor delays.

Demolition of the existing bridge will begin in late October or early November and construction will continue on the second half of the new structure. Watercraft operators are advised that traffic control *may* occur during demolition this fall and are advised to prepare for short term delays on the river within the project limits.
