CALTRANS BEGINS RUMBLE STRIP PROJECT NEAR WRIGHTWOOD

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) began the \$104 thousand project to install centerline and shoulder rumble strips on State Route 2 (SR 2) from the intersection of Wright Mountain Road to the State Route 138 (SR 138) junction near Wrightwood.

The work will take place Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. A single lane closure will be necessary to perform the work. Because of the lane closure, flagging operations with a pilot car will be necessary to perform traffic control through the work area. Signage was placed the week of August 7 by Caltrans to advise motorists of the construction work.
