STATE ROUTE 38 PAVING PROJECT UPDATE

SAN BERNARDINO- Caltrans and All American Asphalt continue the ten-million dollar rehabilitation project on State Route 38 between Forest Falls and Greenway Drive in Big Bear. Guardrail installation is a provision of this project. Operations will change today to include the installation of guardrail from Valley of The Falls Drive to Hatchery Road.

Work hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. with one-way traffic control in place at both the paving and the guardrail installation locations. Anticipate minor delays, add time to your commute, and pre-arrange your travel plans.

The rolled asphalt requires a “rest period” of up to two hours. There will be no access across the asphalt during the rest period. Driveways will be affected by this project. Residents and business owners are asked to plan ahead for relocation of your vehicles. Crews will be working in one and a half mile segments. Paving operations and guardrail installation may be delayed if affected by weather.
