INTERSTATE 10 DESERT CENTER PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$95 million Interstate 10 (I-10) Pavement Rehabilitation Project. The project will rehabilitate 124 lane miles of pavement in both directions of I-10 between Cactus City and State Route 177 junction (SR-177).

Pavement work will be eastbound between Chiriaco Summit and SR-177 Junction/Desert Center Rice Road. Eastbound I-10 will be down to **ONE** lane Monday through Friday between 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. No ramps are expected to be closed during this time.

The details of work for **August 22 to August 26, 2016** are detailed below:
