REPAIRS BEGIN ON STATE ROUTE 243

RIVERSIDE COUNTY- California Department of Transportation will begin a \$1.9-million project to surface seal SR-243 from Keenwild (approximately) to one half mile west of Vista Point (approximately). Construction begins Monday, August 31st and will occur during the hours of 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Completion is estimated to take three weeks. One lane traffic control will be in effect. This project moves forward through the use of Federal Stimulus Funds. It is one of fourteen projects in the Inland Empire that received \$200.9 million in federal stimulus funding.

No work is scheduled during the Labor Day holiday.
