Interstate 10 / Riverside Avenue Interchange
Eastbound On and Off Ramps to Close for 32 Hours

Rialto, Ca – As part of the ongoing improvement project at the Interstate 10 / Riverside Avenue Interchange, the eastbound on and off ramps will close from 11:00 pm on Friday, August 26th through 7:00 am on Sunday, August 28th.

This 32-hour extended closure will allow the contractor to perform concrete paving at the ramp at Riverside Avenue. In addition, shifting concrete barriers and applying new striping will facilitate a switch of the traffic pattern to keep the project moving towards completion.

Ultimately, the new interchange will be nine lanes wide with three-lane wide ramps. Riverside Avenue will be widened between the freeway and Valley Boulevard for improved overall operation of the interchange and better flow of traffic on local streets. The project is scheduled for completion in November 2011.
