## Traffic Signal Installation at State Route 74 (SR-74) and Theda Street

**Perris**—A project to install a traffic signal at the intersection of SR-74 Theda Street near the City of Perris in Riverside County began on August 12, 2014. The signal is needed to improve traffic movement to and from Theda Street, as well as to enhance safety at the intersection.

The schedule for work for the next two weeks is as follows:

- August 25 to August 29, 2014 – 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- September 2 to September 5, 2014 – 6 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Please note that during work hours there will be one way traffic control utilizing flaggers. There will be minimal delays to motorists during the flagging, so use an alternate route to avoid the work if possible. Be alert, and pay attention to all signs and workers providing direction throughout the project limits.
