STATE ROUTE 138 (EAST) REALIGNMENT PROJECT TO BEGIN

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin work on the \$23 million State Route 138 (SR-138) East Realignment Project on September 6, 2016. The project will take place from SR-138 east of Interstate 15 to Summit Post Office Road. The realignment will take out several curves and steep grades, reducing the three-mile stretch by one mile. The project also includes constructing outside shoulders, three bridges, and three wildlife crossings. SR-138 will remain a two-lane road with one lane in each direction. Construction is expected to be completed by summer 2018.

The project will require traffic breaks and some full closures to complete the construction work. Advanced warning signs will be placed to inform motorists of various roadwork activities.
