INTERSTATE 10 AUXILIARY LANE PROJECT UPDATE #2

San Bernardino – Construction continues next week to add an auxiliary lane to Interstate 10 (I-10) from Waterman Avenue to the Alabama Street Overcrossing. The project is in San Bernardino, Loma Linda and Redlands. Work includes restriping the eastbound roadbed for the auxiliary lane, adding four overhead signs and repaving the median.

Closures will occur during the times and locations shown below. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. No work will take place over the Labor Day weekend from 6 a.m. Friday morning, September 4, to 6 p.m. Tuesday evening, September 8.

Please follow all advisory signs and **SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE**. The California Highway Patrol will be enforcing reduced speed limits in the construction zone. This alert will be updated each week during construction, which is expected to last until early October.
