WHO: Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

WHY: To construct a regional drainage facility

WHEN: Work is scheduled to begin on **September 9, 2009**. All of the work will be completed during the day, however, the westbound off-ramp will remain closed at night due to safety concerns. The work is expected to last 10 days.

The work will begin on **September 9, 2009**. It is anticipated that the first phase of construction will be completed on **September 18, 2009**.
