## WORK CONTINUES ON STATE ROUTE 371 (SR-371) SHOULDER WIDENING PROJECT

**SAN BERNARDINO**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$6.2 million State Route 371 (SR-371) Shoulder Widening Project. Flagging is expected on SR-371 at various locations within the project limits Monday-Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This safety project will construct a four foot right shoulder in each direction of SR-371 near Anza and Cahuilla from east of Cary Road to east of Kirby Road. Drainage work and minor landscape work will also be performed as part of the project.

Constructing the four foot outside shoulder in both directions is expected to reduce the number and severity of collisions on SR-371.
