COMMUTER ALERT 91 HOV PROJECT UPDATE **FULL NIGHTTIME FREEWAY CLOSURES** **AT PACHAPPA RAILROAD BRIDGE**

Riverside – Caltrans continues construction on the new six-mile long High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) project on State Route 91. Preparations are continuing for the building of the temporary (shoofly) railroad bridge at Pachappa. This temporary bridge will be used while the new railroad bridge is being built.

Beginning Monday, September 16th – Thursday, September 19th, and will resume again on Monday, September 23rd - Saturday, September 26th, the contractor will begin erecting girders at the Pachappa railroad bridge. In order to safely bring heavy equipment onto the highway, the entire freeway will need to be closed to traffic during nighttime and early morning hours.
