UNITED STATES ROUTE 395 COLD PLANE AND OVERLAY PROJECT

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) was scheduled to begin work on the \$12.5 million United States Route 395 (US-395) cold plane and overlay project on April 18th. **Due to the need for additional time for the development of the “Superpave” mix design, the project has been under temporary suspension until early September. The new start date for construction is scheduled for Sunday, September 11 at 6:00 P.M.** Construction is anticipated to last 90 working days, weather permitting. The contract has been awarded to Sully-Miller Contracting Company. The cold plane and overlay project is necessary to provide a smoother driving surface within the project limits.

The project will replace 27.5 miles of asphalt pavement in both directions from post mile 46 to post mile 73.5 near Kramer Junction. Construction crews will operate under 1-way traffic control during working hours, which are expected to be from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. Construction activities are expected to begin each week on Sunday evening and conclude on Friday morning.
