CALTRANS TO PERFORM SIDEWALK AND CURB UPGRADES IN NORTHERN SAN BERNARDINO

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will initiate a project on State Route 18 (SR-18), also known as Waterman Avenue, in between 40th Street and 43rd Street in the City of San Bernardino to upgrade the sidewalks, remove metal beam guardrail, and reconstruct curbs and driveways.

The \$150,000 project will begin on Monday, September 12. The project is expected to last for 30 working days with construction operations taking place Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Next week, crews will begin working on SR-18 south bound and will require one of two lanes to be closed in order to protect the workers and work area from live traffic. Please be patient and allow additional trip time to traverse the project area lane closure.
