STATE ROUTE 177 PAVEMENT REPAIR PROJECT

RIVERSIDE/SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) began work on State Route 177 (SR-177) pavement repair project between Interstate 10 (I-10) and State Route 62 (SR-62) in Riverside County. The \$4.1 million project was awarded to VSS International, Inc. and consist of localized dig-outs, crack seals, and seal coats. The work is necessary to prolong the pavement surface and provide motorist with a smoother driving surface.

SR-177 between I-10/Desert Center Rice Road and SR-62/Twenty-nine Palms Highway will be under one-way traffic control between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday for the next 30 days.

In addition, I-10 east and westbound on/off-ramps will be closed at various times. Detours for ramp closures will be available and signed.

The details of work for September 12 to October 14, 2016 are as follows:
