U.S. HIGHWAY 95 DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project Receives \$2.6 Million in Federal Stimulus Funding

RIVERSIDE COUNTY– the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has begun a \$4 million project to improve drainage along U.S. Highway 95 approximately 24 miles north of Blythe. It is one of fourteen projects in District 8, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties, to receive federal stimulus funding.

One lane traffic control will be in effect from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. as the project progresses along the 9-mile long project. Completion is expected by late November.
