Paving Project Begins on SR62

San Bernardino County- The California Department of Transportation has awarded a \$2.6-million project to Skanska USA to begin a paving project Monday, September 20th on two sections of SR-62 in San Bernardino County. Sections to be paved are between Elwood and Montanya Road (Twenty Nine Palms area) and from 11 miles east of Ironage Rd to 5 miles west of State Route 177 (Joshua Tree area).

Crews will start closer to Twenty Nine Palms beginning Monday, September 20th. Once the first segment, which will take approximately one week, is completed they will then move to the segment in Joshua Tree. It is estimated that the project will be completed by the end of October.

Work hours for the Twenty Nine Palms segment are Monday through Friday, 6 am. to 6 p.m. Work hours for the Joshua Tree segment are Monday through Friday, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. One-way traffic control will be conducted at both locations. Add extra time to your commute.
