FULL DIRECTIONAL CLOSURE ON INTERSTATE 215 BRIDGE REPAIRS BEGIN

RIVERSIDE COUNTY- California Department of Transportation has awarded a \$400 thousand project to Adams and Smith, Inc. to begin repairs on the McCall Boulevard overcrossing on southbound I-215 in Riverside County. The false work needed for bridge repair will be erected between Tuesday, September 28th and Friday October 1st with all work on the structure estimated for completion by early December this year.

The southbound I-215 will be closed Tuesday through Friday nights (noted above) between 10 p.m. and 4 a.m. Traffic will detour to the McCall Boulevard exit ramp, cross over McCall Boulevard and immediately re-enter I-215 using the southbound on ramp.

The bridge was struck by an oversized load on September 9th that makes it necessary to repair girder damage and spot paint the section. Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their continued patience and support. Caltrans asks that motorist be aware of the construction area and always make a point to-
