SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) & San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG) are continuing work on the I-215 Widening Project. This week crews are working on various bridges, walls, ramps, connectors, in the median and installing overhead signs throughout the project area, weather permitting.

We remind motorists that the legal speed limit has been reduced to 55 mph through the construction area. Please slow down and keep a safe driving distance from the vehicle in front of you.

Thursday, September 27- Friday, September 28 10:00 pm – 6:00 am	Full SB I-215 from SR-210 to 5th St.	Take WB SR-210 and exit State St., turn right to Highland Ave., right on Highland, right on Mt. Vernon to 5 th St, left to re-enter SB I-215.
Sunday, September 23 - Friday, September 28 SB 8:00 pm to 4:00 am / NB 10:00 pm to 6:00 am nightly	NB and SB I-215 alternating lane closures between Rialto Ave. and University Pkwy.	No detour necessary as at least one lane will remain open when full freeway closures are not taking place.
Monday, September 24- Friday, September 28 8:00 pm – 4 am	SB SR-259 connector	Take SB SR-259 and exit Highland Ave. Turn left on Highland Ave., turn right on H St., turn right on 5 th St. to access the SB I-215 on-ramp.
