STATE ROUTE 60 BRIDGE WORK IN RIVERSIDE COUNTY UPDATE #6

Riverside - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues to repair bridges along State Route 60 in Riverside County. Work includes repairing bridge decks and joint seals, and overlaying concrete on bridges from Interstate 15 (I-15) to the Pacific Avenue Undercrossing.

Closures will occur as needed during the times and at locations shown below. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time.

Detours

Eastbound SR-60 to northbound I-15: Take I-15 south to Cantu-Galleano Ranch Road and turn left. Turn left again onto northbound I-15.

Country Village Road/Mission Blvd. Overcrossing:

Southbound traffic detours to westbound SR-60. Exit at Etiwanda and turn left. Turn left again onto eastbound SR-60 and exit on Country Village Road/Mission Blvd. to continue southbound.

Northbound traffic detours to eastbound SR-60. Exit at next available off-ramp and turn left. Turn left again onto westbound 60 and exit at Country Village Road to continue northbound.

Pedley Road Overcrossing:

Southbound traffic detours to westbound SR-60. Exit at next available off-ramp and turn left. Turn left again on SR-60 eastbound. Exit at Pedley Road to continue southbound.

Northbound traffic detours to eastbound SR-60. Exit at Pyrite Street and turn left. Turn left again onto westbound 60 and exit at Pedley Road to continue northbound.
