UPCOMING CHANGES TO THE INTERSTATE 15 CAJON PASS MANAGED CROSSOVER LANES

SAN BERNARDINO – Caltrans, District 8 and Coffman Parsons Joint Venture (CPJV) removed the current southbound Interstate 15 (I-15) managed crossover lanes from just north of State Route 138 (SR-138) to just north of Kenwood Road on Friday, September 25 in time for the 5 a.m. commute. For approximately ten weeks, construction crews worked double shifts, six days a week, to concrete pave a large segment of the I-15 Cajon Pass Pavement Rehabilitation Project, while the southbound I-15 traffic had the option to use the crossover lane. The managed lanes were vital in ensuring the paving operation remained on schedule, protected workers and equipment, as well as provided the best possible product for decades to come.

Next phase of work:

Beginning Wednesday, September 30, a new lane configuration will be installed on the southbound Interstate 15 from just south of Ranchero Road to just south of Oak Hill Road. A 2-lane crossover, approximately 1.5 miles long, will be in place for approximately six (6) weeks. **The southbound I-15 Oak Hill Road off ramp will be closed for approximately 30 days during the southbound crossover. The Truck Brake Check Area will be closed from Monday, September 28 thru Friday, October 30.** Truckers and motorists are advised to exit at Highway 395 in Hesperia and use the truck stop to check brakes. **Motorists wishing to patronize businesses on Oak Hill Road may use the southbound Ranchero Road off-ramp.**

Caltrans asks motorists to continue to plan ahead, check traffic conditions and add extra trip time through the Cajon Pass for the duration of the project.
