

Interstate 10 Citrus & Cherry Interchange Projects

San Bernardino Associated Governments, the City of Fontana, the County of San Bernardino and Caltrans have teamed up to improve the Interstate 10 interchanges at Citrus Avenue and Cherry Avenue in Fontana.

Night-time through early morning lane and ramp closures will be in place for continued bridge structure and support work. Please follow posted detour signs during these closures.

Please refer to the information below for closure details:

INTERSTATE 10 CITRUS AVENUE INTERCHANGE		
The westbound and eastbound Interstate 10 Citrus Avenue Interchange on-ramps and off-ramps are open to motorists. Night-time closures will no longer be required at this interchange. Minor electrical and landscaping activity is currently taking place. Motorists can expect to see electrical and landscaping crews on weekdays. Some lane closures may be required. No detour will be required since at least one travel lane is expected to remain open at all times.		
INTERSTATE 10 CHERRY AVENUE INTERCHANGE		
Mon., Sept. 29 – Thu., Oct. 2 10 pm – 4 am	Westbound Interstate 10 at Cherry Avenue	Alternating freeway lane closures will be required each night and will continue through the following morning. No detour will be required since at least one travel lane is expected to remain open at all times.
	Westbound Interstate 10 Cherry Avenue on-ramp	Intermittent ramp closures will be required each night and will continue through the following morning. During these closures, motorists can use Valley Boulevard or Slover Avenue to connect with the Etiwanda Avenue on-ramp.
	Westbound Interstate 10 Cherry Avenue off-ramp	Intermittent ramp closures will be required each night and will continue through the following morning. During these closures, motorists can use the Etiwanda Avenue off-ramp and travel north to Valley Boulevard or south to Slover Avenue to connect with Cherry Avenue.
Mon., Sept. 29 – Thu., Oct. 2 11 pm – 5 am	Eastbound Interstate 10 at Cherry Avenue	Alternating freeway lane closures will be required each night and will continue through the following morning. No detour will be required since at least one travel lane is expected to remain open at all times.
	Eastbound Interstate 10 Cherry Avenue off-ramp	Intermittent ramp closures will be required each night and will continue through the following morning. During these closures, motorists can use the Etiwanda Avenue off-ramp and travel north to Valley Boulevard or south to Slover Avenue to connect with Cherry Avenue.
Mon., Sept. 29 – Thu., Oct. 2 11 pm – 5 am	Eastbound Interstate 10 Cherry Avenue on-ramp	Intermittent ramp closures will be required each night and will continue through the following morning. During these closures, motorists can use Citrus Avenue on-ramp.
FULL WEEKEND ON-RAMP CLOSURE Fri., Oct. 3 – Sun., Oct. 5 10 pm – 7 am	Eastbound Interstate 10 Cherry Avenue on-ramp	A full ramp closure will be required starting Friday night and will reopen on Sunday morning. During this closure, motorists can use the Citrus Avenue on-ramp.

Please note that construction activities are subject to change, based on contractor's schedule and weather conditions.

When complete, the Interchange projects will replace the current Citrus Avenue bridge over I-10 with a seven-lane bridge and the current Cherry Avenue bridge over the freeway with an eight-lane bridge. The project also will widen the bridges over the railroad tracks and improve on-ramps and off-ramps. Upgrades will be made at the intersection of Citrus Avenue and Valley Boulevard, Cherry Avenue and Slover Avenue, and other local street improvements.

Thank you for your patience and support during these improvement projects. Please be aware of the construction area and always make a point to... **SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE** and **MOVE OVER** a lane when it is safe to do so.
