Ranchero Road Paving Operation Starts Monday

Hesperia, CA – As part of the Ranchero Road Interchange Project, crews will conduct a grinding and paving operation of Ranchero Road from Mariposa Road heading east starting Monday, September 29, and continue for approximately two weeks.

The activity will consist of grinding old pavement and replacing with new, striping, and some utility adjustments to accommodate for future use of Ranchero Road. The roadway will be reduced to one-way traffic control during most of the operation with either pilot cars or flaggers to assist motorists through the construction zone. **Hours of operation will primarily be from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday.** Additional work hours may be necessary depending on production rates for the day or availability of materials and/or equipment.

Motorists are encouraged to either choose alternate routes when available or allow for extra time when traveling through the area. Adverse weather could affect paving portions of the work. Workers and equipment will be active in the area, motorists are asked to use caution for the safety of the crew and themselves.

California Highway Patrol Officers will be present during construction. Please slow for the cone zone.
