SEMA Construction is continuing work at the \$14.8 million Date Palm Drive Interchange Project in Palm Desert. In order for crews to safely complete the concrete paving in the middle of the intersection, ramps and roads will need to be closed

The eastbound I-10 off-ramp will be closed beginning at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, October 1 and the ramp will remain closed until between 9 p.m. and 2 a.m (Wednesday, Oct 2) to remove K-rail barrier and perform some electrical work. Once this work is completed, the eastbound off-ramp will open. The westbound on and off-ramps will close after the eastbound off-ramp is opened on Tuesday, October 1 and will remain closed until Friday, October 11 at 9 p.m. Date Palm Drive will also close from north of the eastbound ramps to Varner Road at the same time as the westbound ramp closures.

The eastbound I-10 ramps at Date Palm Drive continue to be restricted to “No Left Turns.”

The Date Palm Dr. Intersection Project is scheduled to be completed in January 2014.
