Interstate 10 Bridge Rehabilitation Project Begins

San Bernardino County – Monday night, October 4, crews will begin rehabilitating pavement and replacing seals on I-10 bridges in San Bernardino County. The project will extend from the Riverside Ave. overcrossing in Rialto to the New York St. undercrossing in Redlands. It was awarded to Coffman Specialties, Inc. for \$1,787,782.

The work will take place Monday through Friday nights as shown in the table below. At least one lane will be available at all times on I-10. It will be necessary to close ramps when paving is being done in the area of the ramp.
