



*Northbound and southbound I-215 will be closed at night Oct. 4th, 5th, and 6th as well as Oct. 9th to 13th for work at the Baseline Street bridge.*

Attention commuters! I-215 will be closed in both directions at night on Oct. 4th, 5th, and 6th to safely remove temporary bridge structures at Baseline Street.

The closures will take place between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Southbound travelers will be detoured to westbound SR-210 and taken off at State Street. For more information about this detour, please click on this [link](#).

Northbound travelers will be taken off at the Baseline Street exit. For a map of the detour and turn-by-turn directions, you can click on this [link](#).


Full nighttime freeway closures are also planned for Oct. 9th through the 13th.


