## INTERSTATE 10 DESERT CENTER PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

**RIVERSIDE** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$95 million Interstate 10 (I-10) Pavement Rehabilitation Project. The project will rehabilitate 124 lane miles of pavement in both directions of I-10 between Cactus City and State Route 177 (SR-177) junction.

For the next two weeks pavement work will be on eastbound I-10 between Cactus City Rest Area and Chiriaco Summit. The eastbound I-10 will be down to **ONE** lane Monday through Friday. Cactus City/Cactus City Compressor Station, Box Canyon Road, and Pinto Road on/off ramps will be closed between 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. as detailed below.

The details of work for **October 4 to October 16, 2016** are as follows:
