INTERSTATE 10 REDLANDS PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT PROJECT WESTBOUND CROSSOVER LANE UNDERWAY

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$26 million Interstate 10 (I-10) Pavement Replacement Project. The project replaces concrete pavement in both directions of I-10 between Ford Street in the City of Redlands and Live Oak Canyon Road in the City of Yucaipa.

Construction crews have begun constructing the westbound crossover lane. For the next week motorists can expect to see work within the median and number two (2) lanes east and westbound to switch the crossover lane to the westbound I-10. Motorist can also expect to see reduced lanes and intermediate ramp closures for lane striping. Work will take place Monday through Sunday between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., nightly.

Motorist are advised that the speed limit is reduced to **55 MPH** and lane widths have been reduced to 11 feet.
