## UPDATE—PHASE 2 OF STATE ROUTE 79 PAVEMENT PROJECT BEGINS

**SAN BERNARDINO**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 8, and All American Asphalt have started work on the second phase of the \$1.4 million paving project on State Route 79 (SR-79).

The paving portion of the project, which was completed at the end of August, was the first phase of the project. Now crews are working to reconstruct the curb ramps to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, as well as perform work on the loop detectors at the intersection of SR-79 and First Street in Beaumont. The work will take place from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Monday-Friday and is expected to be complete by the end of next week. Final striping at the crosswalks will follow.
