## State Route 91 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Week of October 8, 2012

**Irvine**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue to resurface the Westbound State Route 91 from Beach Boulevard Undercrossing to Stanton Avenue Undercrossing in Buena Park. Full on-ramp closures will occur at the Westbound Beach Boulevard Loop On-ramp from Northbound Beach Boulevard. Changeable message signs and detours will be posted.
