BE WORK ZONE ALERT!

STATE ROUTE (SR) 138 HORSETHIEF CREEK BRIDGE TRAFFIC SWITCH

HESPERIA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is replacing the SR-138 Horsethief Creek Bridge in Hesperia, CA. The new bridge, estimated at \$5.8 million, will be designed to resist local environmental conditions. The two-lane undivided conventional highway serves the communities of Crestline, Summit Valley and Silverwood Lake. The project is expected to be complete mid-December 2015.

On Monday, October 12th traffic will be switched to the eastbound side of Horsethief Creek Bridge. The eastbound side will be used for travel as an alternating lane via signalization.

Motorists can expect up to an **hour delay** during the traffic switch while the temporary signals are being re-positioned. The traffic switch is necessary to build the westbound side of Horsethief Creek Bridge. Please add time to your commute the morning of October 12, 2015.
