STORM WATCH-CHAIN CONTROL

San Bernardino/Riverside County – Mountain Area chain control in multiple areas. Below is a list of chain control locations and other information. Caltrans advises motorist to drive with caution and reduce your speed.

DATE As of:	LOCATION AND AREA	CHAIN CONTROL RESTRICTION	DURATION
Thurs. Oct. 11 th	SR-2 (5 miles West of Big Pines to Los Angeles/San Bernardino County line)	R-2	Until further notice
Thurs. Oct 11th	SR-18 from Heaps Peak Dump thru Junction SR-330	R-2	Until further notice
Thurs. Oct. 11 th	SR-18 Running Springs thru Arrowhead Ranch	R-2	Until further notice
Thurs. Oct. 11 th	SR-18 (.5 miles east of Junction SR-330 to Green Valley Road	R-2	Until further notice
Thurs. Oct. 11 th	SR-18 from Green Valley Road to Snow Valley	R-2	Until further notice

Thurs. Oct. 11 th	SR-18 from Lower Waterman Canyon to Vista Point	R-2	Until further notice
Thurs. Oct. 11 th	SR-18 from Snow Valley to Big Bear Dam	R-2	Until further notice
Thurs. Oct. 11 th	SR-18 from Snow Valley to Junction SR-330	R-2	Until further notice
Thurs. Oct. 11 th	SR-18 from Big Bear to Snow Valley	R-2	Until further notice

Please remember to carry chains in your vehicle if you travel to mountain areas. Changes in weather or road conditions happen quickly.

CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:

- W: **No Restrictions** - Watch for snow on pavement.
- R-1: Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle.
- R-2: *Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.*
- R-3: Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.
