## STATE ROUTE 138 (WEST) WIDENING PROJECT TRAFFIC SWITCH

**SAN BERNARDINO**—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$52.1 million State Route 138 (SR-138) Widening (West) Project.

Flagging operations are expected on SR-138 from Interstate 15 to SR-2 between the hours of 7:00 pm and 5:00 a.m., Monday through Friday. The flagging operations are necessary to complete paving, striping and K-rail placement in order to move traffic north onto the new roadway.

The details of work for **October 10 to October 14, 2016** are as follows:
