DEVORE 2 UPDATE

CLOSURES BEGIN AT 9:00 A.M. ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 13

San Bernardino County – Caltrans continues the Devore 2 Pavement Rehabilitation project on Interstate 15 (I-15) near the junction of 15/215 in Devore (just south of the Cajon Pass). Most of the work will be completed at night; however, Caltrans has planned approximately five weekends of Rapid Rehab work. *The Rapid Rehab weekend work will continue each weekend through November 2006. [This schedule could change if it rains. Check for updates on the website before you leave.](#)*

Schedule for this weekend (Closure C):

Friday, October 13 from 9:00 a.m. to Sunday, October 15 at 1:00 p.m.:
Southbound I-15 connector to southbound I-15 will be closed **24 hours a day**.

Southbound I-15 travelers will be routed to southbound I-215 through San Bernardino to westbound Interstate 10 and continue to I-15. Motorists are urged to plan ahead or take an alternate route, if possible. Substantial delays are expected.

A concert will be held at Hyundai Pavilion (Glen Helen Pavilion) the evening of Saturday, October 14. Delays are expected to be substantial on I-15 and I-215 in the area of the "Pavilion". **Concert-goers are urged to plan ahead and add extra travel time.** Access to the concert is as follows:

Southbound I-15 from High Desert: Take I-15 south to I-215 south to Devore Rd. Exit and turn left to Glen Helen Parkway, turn right to the "Pavilion".

Northbound I-15 from Los Angeles area: Take I-15 north to Glen Helen Parkway, exit and turn right to the "Pavilion".

From Beach cities, Orange County, Riverside and San Bernardino: Take I-215 north to Palm/Kendall, exit and turn left under freeway and turn right on Kendall (Kendall becomes Cajon Blvd.). Go to Glen Helen Parkway then turn left to the "Pavilion".
