## INTERMITTENT CLOSURES WILL TAKE PLACE ON STATE ROUTE 38 HATHAWAY CREEK BRIDGE PROJECT

**HESPERIA** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues the bridge rehabilitation project on State Route 38 (SR-38) at Hathaway Creek Bridge near Barton Flats. The \$1.6 million will upgrade the pavement, bridge rails, and replace the bridge deck and approach slabs. Project benefits include improved access for increased truck traffic and new pavement with extended life requiring less maintenance. The project is expected to be complete in late 2015.

On **Wednesday, October 14<sup>th</sup>** traffic will be stopped, intermittently, for 30 minutes in order to remove false work from the construction area. The intermittent 30 minute closures will occur from **8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday only**. Please add time to your commute on October 14, 2015.
