GUARDRAIL PROJECT BEGINS ON STATE ROUTE 18

San Bernardino - The California Department of Transportation will begin a \$798 thousand project Monday, October 19th to install guardrail at 11 different locations along State Route 18 in the San Bernardino Mountains. The project will begin at the junction of State Route 18/138 and will continue just east of State Route 173. Work hours are Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Flagging operations (and pilot cars when distance and sight visibility requires) will be used to control traffic in the construction zone.

This is a 50 working day project but could be subject to weather-related delays. Please allow extra time for your commute and observe advisory signs that will be posted in the project limits.

Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their continued patience and support during this improvement project. Caltrans asks that motorist be aware of the construction area and always make a point to ***SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE***. The life you save may be your own!
