NEW HORSETHIEF CREEK BRIDGE FOR STATE ROUTE (SR) 138

Hesperia – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be replacing the SR-138 Horsethief Creek Bridge in Hesperia, CA. The new bridge, estimated at \$5.8 million, will be designed to resist local environmental conditions. The two-lane undivided conventional highway serves the communities of Crestline, Summit Valley and Silverwood Lake. The project is scheduled to begin October 20, 2014.

The new Horsethief Creek Bridge will be built in two halves. The remaining half will be used for travel as an alternating lane via signalization. A temporary signal will be installed on Monday, October 20th for one way traffic control purposes and will be activated the following week, Monday, October 27, 2014. Motorists can expect minor delays for the signalized traffic control.
