BE WORK ZONE ALERT!

UPDATE- STATE ROUTE 18 PAVING PROJECT

SAN BERNARDINO-The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and Match Corporation will resume work on Monday, October 19 for the \$4 million paving project on State Route 18 (SR 18). The work with traffic control will continue uphill in the down bound lane of SR 18.

The construction schedule for next week is provided below. ***Be advised that dates and times may change based on weather or construction progress.***

Friday October 23	SR 18 in Running Springs	9:00 am to 5:00 p.m.

CHP will be assisting with traffic control in Rim Forest and at Rim High School. Parents are advised to use the back gate at Rim High School to drop off and pick up their kids to help alleviate traffic delays.

Motorists driving to Big Bear are advised that that other roadwork exists on state highways: SR 18 between Snow Valley Resort and Big Bear Dam is closed Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and SR 38 has traffic control from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for paving.

During paving operations, access to SR 18 is restricted until the hot asphalt has cooled sufficiently. Make parking arrangements outside of the construction zone if the project is in your area. ***Add some time to your commute for delays, which are averaging from 15 to 30 minutes.***
