STATE ROUTE 18 ASPHALT CONCRETE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

SAN BERNARDINO – A project to remove and replace asphalt concrete (AC), as well as repairing and replacing bridge joint seals continues next week on State Route 18 (SR-18) in the San Bernardino Mountains between State Route 210 (SR-210) to the junction of SR-18/SR-138, and the SR-18/SR-330 separation.

Work is conducted from 8 a.m. - 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday, October 21 – October 24, and from 8 a.m - 4 p.m. on Friday, October 25. During construction, both the south and northbound lanes are alternately closed and all traffic is diverted to the opposite lanes. There is one lane open in each direction.

On Wednesday, October 23 from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., crews will pave the SR-18 bridge deck at the SR-18/SR-210 separation in the city of San Bernardino. The California Highway Patrol (CHP) will direct traffic at the SR-210 east on and off-ramps, and the SR-18/East 30th Street intersection. **EXPECT MAJOR DELAYS.**
