

74/215 INTERCHANGE PROJECT CONSTRUCTION ALERT



PERRIS – The Riverside County Transportation Commission and project partners continue constructing the 74-215 Interchange (also known as the 4th Street Interchange). Installation of concrete barriers along the northbound off-ramp and at the former southbound off-ramp plus drainage work on Redlands Avenue will require closures. The long-term 4th Street southbound off-ramp closure has been postponed as noted below.

Closures will be required as follows, weather permitting:

Closure Activity	Closure Location	Date, Time and Details
Rescheduled Full long-term ramp closure	Southbound I-215 4 th Street off-ramp	Saturday night, October 9 Long-term ramp closure has been rescheduled from Friday, October 8 to Saturday, October 9 at 11 pm and will be in place for approximately one year. During this closure, motorists will be directed to the temporary off-ramp south of the 4 th Street overcrossing connecting to westbound 4 th Street.
Freeway lane closure	Southbound I-215 - between Perris Boulevard Overcrossing & the temporary 4 th Street off-ramp	Monday night, October 11 Lane closure will occur from 9 pm to 5 am the following morning. One travel lane and 4 th Street off-ramp will remain open during this closure.
Freeway lane closure	Northbound I-215 - from Redlands Avenue off-ramp to Perris Boulevard Overcrossing	Monday night, October 11 Lane closure will occur from 9 pm to 4 am the following morning. One travel lane will remain open during this closure.
Off-ramp closure	Northbound I-215 off-ramp at 4th Street	Monday night, October 11 Ramp closure will occur from 9 pm to 4 am the following morning. During this closure, motorists will be directed to use the Nuevo Road off-ramp.
Lane closures	Redlands Avenue from the I-215 Overcrossing to 4 th Street	Monday night, October 11 Eastbound and westbound lane closures will occur from 9 pm to 5 am the following morning. One travel lane in each direction will remain open during these closures. A flagging operation will be in place to direct motorists through the area.

The project will pave the way for better traffic flow, easier access to downtown Perris and improved connections to both north and south Interstate 215. The project will replace the current two-lane bridge over the freeway with an eight-lane bridge, realign freeway ramps, widen streets, replace stop signs with traffic signals, add a sidewalk north of the bridge and build residential sound walls. Throughout construction, please remember to **Slow for the Cone Zone!**
