Pavement Repair Project Begins on U.S. Highway 95

San Bernardino County- The California Department of Transportation has awarded a \$1.7-million project to Intermountain Slurry, Inc. to begin a pavement repair and scrub seal project Monday, October 25th on U.S. Hwy 95 and SR-62, Vidal Junction, in San Bernardino County. Completion is estimated in early December.

Work hours are Monday through Friday, 5 am. To 6 p.m. Crews will be placing construction advisory signs along the route this week. One-way traffic control with pilot car will occur through the project limits. Add extra time to your commute.
