DISTRICT CRASH CUSHION REPLACEMENT PROJECT

SAN BERNARDINO—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a project next week to replace the crash cushion at various locations on four different state routes (Interstates 10, and 15 and State Routes 60 and 71). The \$480,000 project was awarded to Traffic Development Services, Inc. of Moorpark, Calif.
