CALTRANS COMMUTER ALERT UPDATED

EB/WB State Route 91 at Imperial Highway Full Freeway Closure October 23rd

WHAT: All lanes Eastbound State Route 91 between from Imperial Highway to Weir Canyon Road and Westbound SR-91 from Weir Canyon to Imperial Highway will be closed. The closure includes the 91 Express Lanes in both directions. The City of Anaheim will be performing electrical work. High voltage power lines that span the freeway are being relocated as underground utilities. The closure is required to remove the overhead lines.

Changeable Message Signs will be in place to alert motorists of the construction activity and available detours.

CMS and detour route signs will be in place.</p>
